A Sonata is work written for single instrument or two instruments. It has 4 movements (Allegro, Andante, dance form Quick). 32 Sonata - Beethoven.

A Concerto is a large work for a solo instrument accompanied by the orchestra. Cadenza ending with a long trill. (Ex: 27 Piano Concerto - Mozart, 6 Brandenburg Concerto - Bach)
